

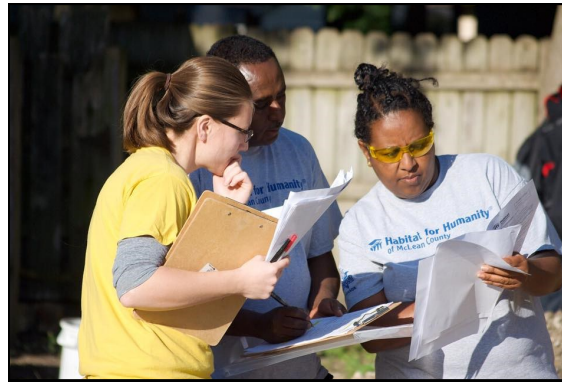

How To Qualify

Housing Need

- Structural or mechanical problems
- Overcrowding
- Subsidized or temporary housing
- Unaffordable
- Crime/Safety concerns



Ability to Pay

- 60% of Medium Area Income
- Low debt-to-income ratio
- Able to pay the 25 year, no-interest mortgage of their home (monthly mortgage, taxes & insurance approx. \$500)

Willingness to Partner

- 250 hours of sweat equity per adult
 - ⇒ 25 hours on other Habitat homes
 - ⇒ 25 hours at ReStore
- Attend workshops (Budgeting, Home Maintenance, etc.)
